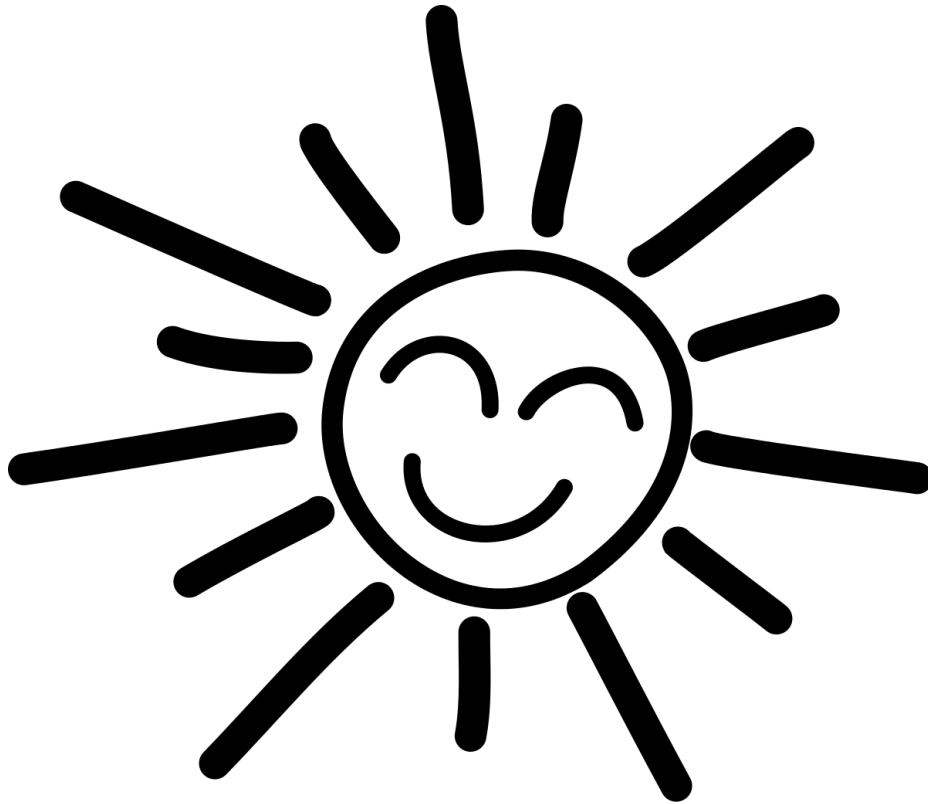


2018 Summer Recreation Program!

We once again will run our program in coordination with the Green Lake Summer School. The recreation program is scheduled to begin Monday, June 18, and run for 5 weeks thru Friday July 20. All activities are subject to change and will be posted at the school or at City Hall. Activities will be held in the City Hall gymnasium on rainy days. In the event that the heat index is projected to be dangerously high, the recreation department may choose to cancel the program for the day for safety of the participants or we will make other arrangements to beat the heat. For Hattie Sherwood Beach and Berlin Aquatic Center make sure you pack sunscreen, towels and anything else your child needs. We are not responsible for lost clothing or towels.

Drop off/Pick up Information

All children not attending summer school should be dropped off at the Elementary school at 12:00. If they are attending summer school they will meet with the recreation staff at the end of school each day. Pick up is at Playground Park at 4-4:30.

For Field Trips, please make sure you drop your child off at the City Hall at 8am and pick up at 4pm. Please be on time as we have scheduled arrival times for tours.
