Leaves and Brush Policy

Brush Pick Up

- The first Monday of each month starting May 1st thru Nov. 6th.
- If a Holiday falls on a Monday, Brush will be picked up on Tuesday.
- **Do not put brush out more than two days prior to pick –up.**
- A city truck *may be available* for transporting larger quantities of brush, if you do not have a truck or trailer. Call City Hall @ 920-294-6912 for availability
- Storm damage Brush Pick-up may be considered if damage is extreme, call City Hall.
- Brush must be piled neatly with cut ends toward street with **no yard waste mixed in**
- Brush piles larger than a pick-up truck load will not be picked up. Or will be charged a fee.
- Contractor piles will not be picked up.

Leaf Pick Up **Date may be altered due to weather.**

- Spring April 3rd thru May 1st - weather permitting.
- Fall, October 2nd thru Dec. 4th - weather permitting.
- Place leaves within 5 ft. of the curb away from mailboxes, trees, and garbage
- Place leaves on curb, but not in the roadway
- Leaves placed by contractors will not be picked-up.

Curb side Bulky Waste Pick-up will be Monday May 8th.

- No Electronics -TVs, Microwaves, Computers, Dehumidifiers, Washer, Dryers and Refrigerators
- Electronics can be disposed of at Grant Pack-n-ship, Ripon, or Sadoff E-Recycling, Fond du lac

Compost Site – Residential Use Only at 570 Lake Steel St

- 7:30 a.m.–3:00 p.m. - Monday through Friday
- 8:00 am – 4:00pm - Saturday from April 8th thru Dec 2nd
- An attendant will be on duty *most* Saturdays for assistance.
- Mirror stickers will be provided to each resident at city hall. We are asking you to apply it to the back of your inside mirror or have available so when visiting the site our employees can verify residency. The materials deposited at this site must be from within the city limits.
- Please put brush and yard waste in appropriate areas. **DO NOT MIX TOGETHER.**
- No contractors can use the site. The area will be monitored by video cameras for security.
- No Brush will be accepted from Commercial Properties.

Dumpsters – Bulky Waste. **Sight is under video surveillance, Violators will be fined!!**

- On-site week of May 22nd Until limited number of dumpsters are filled.
- **It is a violation** to drop off electronics, dehumidifiers, televisions, computers, concrete, tires, residential garbage, bulk cardboard, and paper in these dumpsters.

Mulching and Compost Pile

Residences are encouraged to mulch and compost. It is much better for your lawn and the environment. Residents are also encouraged to create their own compost pile. It is easy to do. Just form a pile with grass clippings and garden waste. Turn the pile once per month and water if it gets too dry. After it decomposes you will have great topsoil for flower beds and gardens.
