

**CITY OF GREEN LAKE AD HOC COMMITTEE MEETING
FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT – JUNE 17, 2021**

Meeting was called to order at 3:30 pm by Chairman Christopher Foos. Pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by a moment of silent meditation.

Minutes: Motion made by McConnell, second by Radis to approve the Minutes of May 13, 2021. Motion carried.

Review emailed Overview and review Action Points from last meeting: Mr. Foos presented an outline of points for discussion which is attached. City would not do the actual work of applying for grants for businesses but rather refer businesses to where they can find grants. Radis and Meier will talk to Green Lake County Board Chairman regarding vacant land north of County Highway Building to acquire it for river walk and other ideas.

Foos and Meier will work on contacting local businesses. Committee discussed six suggestions that Loni Meiborg emailed to Committee members. Discussed how to connect 360 Bowling Alley to the city. Suggestion was made that stop light should be at intersection of State Highway 23 and North Street as a way to support 360 Bowling Alley, and/or request that the speed limit be lowered to 45 mph. Discussed golfing in the area. The Chamber has been doing golf packs and has been doing well with it.
