Revenue Breakdown:

General Property Taxes (57%) \$1,465,711

<u>Miscellaneous Revenue</u>: ex. Short & long-term debt and

surplus balances applied (16%) \$418,644

<u>Inter-governmental Revenue</u>: ex. State Shared Revenue Funds, Highway Aids, Pandemic relief, grants for recycling and library (9%) \$228,311

<u>Inter-governmental Charges for Services:</u> ex. Town funds received for Fire and Emergency Services; Library (8%) \$212,892

Public Charges for Services: ex. Fees for cable TV, Garbage, Campground, and park and gym use (7%) \$184,425.00 **Other Taxes:** ex. Water utility (per PSC rules), state aid for exempt properties (2%) \$45,986

<u>Licenses & Permits:</u> ex. Liquor, Operator, Cigarette, Dog

licenses and building permits (1%) \$36,875

Fines, Forfeitures, Penalties: ex. courts fees & parking tickets \$4,000

<u>Public Safety:</u> to include law enforcement, EMS, Fire and school crossing guards (31%) \$816,197

<u>Debt Services:</u> ex. Short- & long-term loans for major capital improvements. (21%) \$543,526

<u>Public Works:</u> ex. Streets and sidewalks, parking lots, snow removal, trees, street lights (20%) \$528,701 <u>Culture, Recreation, Education:</u> ex. Library, Parks, Gymnasium, Campground, Athletic fields (14%)

<u>General Government:</u> ex. Administration, Clerk-Treasurer, Mayor & Council, Elections, Attorney fees, and City Hall (12%) \$307,852

Other Financing Sources: ex. Contingency fund, sick leave fund, (1%) \$20,770

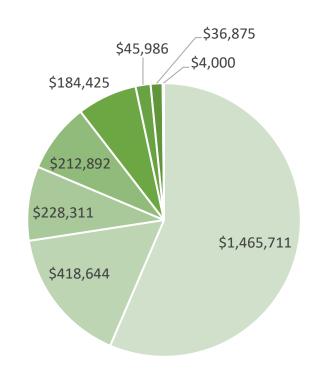

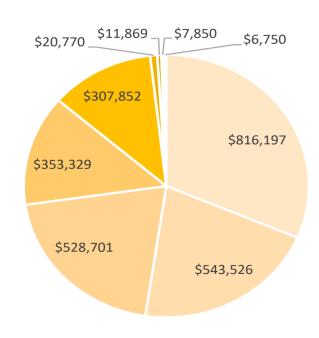
